## **Orange County Announces Free Rabies Clinic for Pets**

*Bring pets to Town of Newburgh for free evaluation on Saturday, September 27*

**Goshen, NY** – Orange County Executive Steve Neuhaus and Health Commissioner Dr. Eli Avila announced today that Orange County, in cooperation with the Town of Newburgh, will hold a free animal rabies vaccination clinic at the Town of Newburgh Highway Department on Saturday, September 27 from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.

The clinics are open to cats, dogs, and ferrets of Orange County residents only. All pets must be restrained by leash or carrier and proof of prior vaccination should be brought to the clinic for the three-year shot. Ferret shots are only good for one year regardless of prior proof of vaccinations.
