A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH
RULES AND REGULATIONS
FOR THE MUNICIPAL COLLECTION
OF TRASH AND RECYCLABLES
PURSUANT TO LOCAL LAW NO. 5 OF THE YEAR 2007
OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLANDS

Councilman/Councilwoman **Monroe** moved the following resolution which was seconded by Councilman/Councilwoman **Kelly**.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Highlands has adopted Local Law No. 5 of Year 2007 entitled "A Local Law Adding a New Article IV to Chapter 160 entitled 'Solid Waste' of the Code of the Town of Highlands: Rules and Regulations for Trash and Recyclable Collections by the Town of Highlands" which provides, among other things, that the Town Board may establish and amend from time to time Rules and Regulations for trash and recyclable collections by the Town of Highlands; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to establish such Rules and Regulations for trash and recyclable collections by the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Highlands does hereby establish the Rules and Regulations for trash and recyclable collection by the Town of Highlands annexed hereto as Exhibit "A" under the title "Proposed Trash PickUp Regulations", such establishment to take effect as hereinafter provided; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the filing of Local Law No. 5 of 2007 with the New York Secretary of State, the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to post the Rules and Regulations on the official signboard of the Town and to publish said Rules and Regulations in a newspaper of general circulation in the Town; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Rules and Regulations shall take effect seven (7) days following the first date of their publication and posting.



TRASH PICKUP REGULATIONS

1. Pickup shall be on days as listed by Sanitation Department
 2. Paper shall be placed curbside in a hard container, paper container or tied and bundled. All shall weigh no more than 35lbs.
 3. Cardboard boxes must be broken down, tied & bundled.
 4. The Town may request commercial properties to supply a dumpster for paper if it is determined volume is excessive.
 5. Recyclables shall be glass and plastic bottles and cans only. They shall be placed curbside in a hard container – plastic bags are not permitted.
 6. Garbage shall be placed curbside by 5:00am. Garbage shall be placed in Town approved receptacle. Garbage shall not be placed directly into containers. It should be placed in clear plastic bags not weighing more than 35lbs. Receptacle shall be removed from roadside by the following day.
 7. Cans shall not be stored at roadside and no structure to house them shall be constructed roadside.
 8. Buildings housing 4 or more apartments shall be required to supply a dumpster of adequate size. If it is determined a dumpster is not practical, then owner shall be required to purchase one Town approved receptacle for every two apartments.
 9. Paint cans must be open and empty.
 10. Hazardous or corrosive materials may not be placed in trash.
 11. Medical waste may not be placed in trash.
 12. Bulk pickup is by appointment only. Propane tanks must have valve removed. Gas engine items such as lawn mowers must have gas and oil drained.
