

## TOWN BOARD

The Town Board, Town of Highlands, held a meeting on Monday, June 27, 2016 at Town Hall, 254 Main St, Highland Falls, NY at 7:00pm.

Supervisor Livsey stated that there was not a quorum, so the Board would be unable to make any decisions, but he asked Todd Atkinson to please give his presentation on the Corbin Hill water system.

Mr. Atkinson said he is the engineer for the Samuel Fredman Trust and he was also hired by the Corbin Hill Homeowner's Association. Mr. Atkinson further stated that Corbin Hill is interested in connecting to the Town water system.

Mr. Atkinson said it is in the best interest of the Town and the homeowners to get them on the Town water system.

Council Member Edsall asked how big the water tank would be and if it was made of steel.

Mr. Atkinson explained the tank would be 50,000 gallons and would be made of steel that is bolted, not welded. Mr. Atkinson said this tank would be inspected every year.

Council Member asked who would own and maintain the tank.

Mr. Atkinson said the Project Water Corporation would, but the Homeowner's Association would like the Town to take over the entire water system.

Mr. Atkinson stated that the water quality would still be the Village's responsibility and that the Town's chlorination system would be a back-up.

Supervisor Livsey said the good thing is we are bringing potable water to potable water so the pipes won't need to be sterilized.

Mr. Atkinson said another benefit of this is that by hooking up Corbin Hill it will get water further up Canterbury Road.

Mr. Rider asked the Supervisor if he wanted him to brief the Board members who were not present on what is going on.

Supervisor Livsey said he would hope they view it on-line and that if a special meeting is needed, one will be called.

The Attorney from John Sarcone's office, said they would like to get this done by the end of the year.

Supervisor Livsey said the Town would cooperate.

Mr. Atkinson gave the Board the Phase III plan, that is ready to go out for review, and discussed it with them.
